Lorenzo Brilli has been playing music since the age of 6 starting with the piano and moving then with passion and curiosity to the rich world of percussion instruments, always influenced by his family background in visual art, ceramics, architecture, design.

He studied drums and percussion at the "Aaron Copland School of Music", New York - Queens College (CUNY) under the guidance of Michael Lipsey, Javier Diaz and Dennis Mackrel and graduated with top marks and honours in Percussion Instruments at the Conservatory of Perugia.

He took part in important Italian and international festivals;

Umbria Jazz Festival (Perugia, Italy), International Winter Arts Festival (Russia), Alternatilla Jazz Festival (Spain), Borneo Jazz Festival (Malaysia), Transilvania Jazz Festival (Cluj-Napoca, Romania), Necessary Noise Festival (New Jersey), Make Music Festival (New York), Goethe Institute (Bucharest), Centrum Paderewskiego (Poland). Sea Cliff Chamber Music Series Festival (Long Island, New York)

He experienced different music contexts from the classical one with Orchestra Sinfonica di Sanremo and Orchestra da Camera di Perugia, to the jazz scene, while studying under the direction of Greg Hutchinson, Antonio Hart, Rodney Green, Billy Hart, Justin Faulkner, Colin Stranahan, Louis Sclavis.

His inclination at fostering cross-cultural exchange and communication was concretely supported by his various experiences.

In 2015, he participated in the Fara Music Festival and at the end of the workshop he was selected as the winner of a scholarship to the "The Collective School of Music" in New York where he had the opportunity to deepen his studies during summer 2016.

He then moved to Queens, New York, where he combined the academic path provided by the **Aaron Copland School of Music, Queens College,** with a more authentic experience of the music scene of New York while collaborating with international and diverse musicians.

It was in this context that he experimented with new music languages such as Balinese Gamelan Music, Batà Drumming from the traditional Afro-Cuban Santeria, Steve Reich minimalist percussion works joined the **Balinese Percussion Ensemble** "Gamelan Yowana Sari" with whom he played in various music festivals in New York and Asia. Furthermore, in 2017 he began an artistic collaboration with the Malaysian pianist Mei Lin Hii in the project "Beat goes Bach" performing on tour in Malaysia, Borneo and Singapore at the Fazioli showroom. The tour was supported by the **Italian Embassy** in Kuala Lumpur and the Borneo Jazz Festival.

Back in Italy, in 2019 he recorded the album "Seamless" (Emme Record) with the Italian jazz sextet "The Sycamore". This record was presented at the Casa del Jazz in Rome and broadcasted on some of the main Italian radio stations such as Rai Radio1 and Rai Radio3.

Keeping in mind the importance of constantly nurturing his artistic vein and exploring new music scenarios, he continued his search while dialoguing with other art forms in particular with dance and drama.

In 2021 he composed the music for the play "I miei incantesimi sono finiti", an original reinterpretation of "The Tempest" by William Shakespeare, by director and actor Samuele Chiovoloni, produced in collaboration with Associazione Argo and Corciano Festival. In the same year he worked as composer and performer with Contemporary Dance Company Malacarne from Seattle (US) during three long artistic residencies in Italy at the Auditorium Santa Cecilia.

In 2022 he was on tour with the acclaimed German pianist Christian Pabst, playing in different music festivals in Europe and recording the album *The Palm Three line*. (Jazz Sick, 2023)

He is currently collaborating with: Malacarne Contemporary Dance Company, Christian Pabst trio, Lorenzo Bisogno quartet, Orchestra da Camera di Perugia, Francesco Poeti trio, Phorminx, HEX, Nicola Fumo Frattegiani. He released his **EP 'Scanners'** on Plus Timbre label in 2023.
